All pupils in KS2 have access to a revision website called CenturyTech. This award winning educational platform is based on artificial intelligence to create a tailored learning pathway for your child. The programme identifies gaps in your child's learning; gives them personalised tasks to address the misconceptions and then checks to ensure they have understood it before moving on.

What else does century do?

- All children complete diagnostic assessments at the beginning and end
- Targets interventions
- Provides home learning
- Aid revision for SATs
- Informs planning
- Encourages parent engagement
- Gives access to 1,000s of learning resources
- Provides teachers with an accurate assessment of children and their progress

The website gives students regular tests on material they have covered in Maths, Reading and SPAG and aids understanding and retention. Using the website is easy. Students go to <https://www.century.tech/>. To login, the students click 'log in' and enter their details. Students already have their username and passwords stuck in the front of their reading journals.

Once logged in, the students follow their 'path, which appears here:



They may also complete specific assignments allocated by the class teacher here.

Class teachers have access to the results and can use these to make appropriate interventions to support the pupils' learning.

You can monitor your child's use of the platform by logging in with their student login details, which will allow you to see their revision time spent and average testing scores.
